Instructions

This test measures your ability to learn and recall new information. First give yourself 45 seconds to study the passage below. You can make rough notes but you cannot look at them or the passage once you begin to answer the questions. You will need to memorise the information in the passage to then answer the questions that follow.

Passage

Before the train doors are operated the conductor must wait until all the passengers have boarded the train safely. If any incidents occur on the train they must alert the train driver and then give a detailed description of the incident to the signaller. The conductor must call the emergency services, if required, via their work mobile phone and inform the operator of the location of the incident and their name.

Once you have read and learnt the passage for 45 seconds cover your notes and the passage. Now go to the next page and answer the questions based on the passage from memory.



Questions

For each question choose the correct answer from the four possible answers – A, B, C, or D. **Do not look at your notes or passage again.**

1. When must the conductor alert the train driver:
 - A. When operating the doors
 - B. If calling the emergency services
 - C. If an incident occurs
 - D. When all passengers have boarded the train

2. What should the conductor do if emergency services are required?
 - A. Alert the train driver
 - B. Wait till all the passengers have alighted the train
 - C. Inform the operator
 - D. Inform the signaller

3. If there is an incident who should receive a detailed description of the event?
 - A. The signaller
 - B. The train driver
 - C. The passengers
 - D. The controller
